

Categories:

1.Official Language

The working language of the APCYS is English.

2. Presentation Format

Each project will be presented by poster and oral presentation.

The author(s) shall present their research work and respond to questions from the jury.

3. Oral Presentation Guidelines

The author deliver oral presentation of the research projects.

- highlight research results predominantly conducted by author.
- * Each presentation shall not exceed 10 minutes.
- * The jury will pose questions for approximately 5 minutes,
 - subject to adjustment by the jury chairperson.

4. Assessment Criteria

Evaluation of each presentation will be based on the following:

- (a) clarity of the problem statement and research question
- (b) justification of methods and techniques to solve problem
- (c) results and conclusions.

5. Awards and Certificates for Winning Projects

Prizes (1st Place, 2nd Place, 3rd Place, and Special Prize) for each categories will be awarded to the winners.

Each member of winning project team receive a certificate.

Poster Format

•Size: 84.1 cm x 118.9 cm (A0, portrait)

Printing: Poster shall be printed in advance by participant

Title:

Include the project title, followed by the author names underneath, and then the names of their respective institutions.

Abstract: Provide a concise summary of your research findings. **Introduction:** Offer a brief background of the project, outlining its context and purpose.


Materials and Experiments:

Describe the materials, equipment, and experimental procedures that contributed to the research results.

Results and Discussion: Present the experimental results and provide a well-justified explanation linking them to the hypothesis.

Conclusions: Summarize the findings and present a clear conclusion based on the results.

References: List all relevant literature and sources utilized in the project.

Airline meals?

A: No! All in-flight meals containing meat shall be declared for quarantine inspections!

into Taiwan?

Canned foods?

A: Human foods processed by specific sterilization canning procedures are allowed. Please consult with the BAPHIQ prior to your travel for more information!

Meat and meat products including vacuum-packed items?

A: No! All kinds of meat and meat products shall be declared for quarantine upon arrival.

Fish products?

A: Only eviscerated and modulated fish product is allowed. Cookies or cakes made with lard? A: Yes, products made with refining processed lard are compliant to the regulations of quarantine.
